Objectives:

Procedures:

1. Welcome

What we are doing – Talk to you a few minutes about a different part of the computer catalog system and show you some personalized features

- 2. Overview of Destiny Card Catalog
 - A. Demonstrate/Review how to access Destiny
 - B. Briefly explain and Perform Example searches

Ask students to give a suggestion to look up

- i. Key word only one word, search for it everywhere in catalog record ex:
- ii. Title- exact or most words correct in title ex:
- iii. Author first and last name or you will get all with same last name ex: Clark
- iv. Subject one word, search for it only in subject list in catalog record ex:
- v. Spelling error does not offer suggestions, Sweeden, none, versus Sweden, yes

3. Introduce Destiny Quest

- A. More user-friendly and personalized catalog tool
- B. Benefits create personal lists, see what's new, what's popular

- 4. Home Page
 - A. Top 10 checkouts, 15 newest additions to the library collection, reference list, ability to log in and put things into a personal list
 - B. Basic Search
 - i. Type in anything here; author, subject, title
 - ii. Results spell incorrectly, gives suggestive spelling
 - Titles, general information
 - Once you select a book, get "might like" suggestions, can also browse shelf
 - C. Advance Search
 - 1. Use more than one term
 - 2. Set limiters (ex: cats, but not dogs)
- 5. My info
 - A. What you have checked out
 - B. What you have in your list
- 6. Always add books to your list of want to read
- 7. Rate books only if you read WHOLE book
 - a. Type in a title
 - b. Select that title
 - c. Select review
 - i. star scale
 - ii. type a short review Mrs. Crone will receive it and approve it first
- 8. Print your list
- 9. Students Log on to computer
- 10. Thing you need to know if you choose to use Quest
 - a. Must log in save things like "to read list" or see what you have checked out
 - b. Must log out for your own security and privacy
 - c. Some information is not available –mostly AR under quiz info
 - Ex: face on milk carton does not, but Voice on the radio does
 - d. Hold Option not recommended, cannot be guaranteed like if you ask at the desk to have a hold placed
